

Aim

To study femmephobia towards effeminate males studying in University of Delhi

Objectives

To identify the effeminate males in University of Delhi.

To assess and understand the experiences of femmephobia with effeminate males.

Methodology

Mixed method i.e. Qualitative and Quantitative research was used. Descriptive research design was used to address the phenomenon. 30 respondents filled online survey questionnaire. 6 interview were taken of participants recruited by simple random sampling and snowball sampling technique. Content analysis method was used to analyse the data.

Findings

Hegemonic systems of gender not only divide but also hierarchically place masculinity above femininity, using Femmephobia to maintain and police the gender divide.

Stereotyping towards effeminates and gender policing were other reasons than feminine expression which provoked femmephobia.
