



AWARENESS OF SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH RIGHTS: A SURVEY AMONG THE YOUTH WITH DISABILITIES IN THE UNIVERSITY OF DELHI

AIM:

To critically analyze the level of awareness towards sexual and reproductive health rights among students with disabilities in the university of Delhi and their related experiences.

GOALS:

- TO DEDUCE THEMES FROM THE UN CONVENTION ON RIGHTS OF PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES FOR MAKING AN EXHAUSTIVE QUESTIONNAIRE FOR THE RESEARCH VARIABLES.
- TO CONDUCT A SURVEY AMONG YOUTH WITH DISABILITIES IN THE UNIVERSITY OF DELHI REGARDING AWARENESS OF SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH RIGHTS AND THEIR RELATED EXPERIENCES.
- TO STATISTICALLY ANALYZE THE RESULTS OF THE SURVEY TO PRODUCE RESULTS IN PERCENTAGES AND GRAPHS.



Possible outcomes :

- Experiences of Youth with Disabilities regarding Sexual and Reproductive Health Rights might be different from Youth without Disabilities.
- Lack of awareness, abuse, and exploitation related to Sexual and Reproductive Health Rights might be common across the heterogeneous population of Youth with Disabilities.
