

## REPORT A Two-day Hands-on Workshop on ICT Embedded Pedagogy 13th-14th December 2022

The workshop idea was born when the students of semester III of M.Sc. Mathematics Education at Cluster Innovation Centre, University of Delhi, in conversation with their mentor Prof. B. Biswal, discussed the inability of teachers to effectively use ICT in their pedagogical practices and the phobia associated with learning of new technologies yet alone using them. To address this issue, Prof. Biswal guided the students to organise a hands-on workshop for a certain number of teachers of the Delhi region schools in which they can be trained from the very basic technology to some useful software and ICT tools that they shall be able to incorporate in their classrooms with ease.

The workshop was organised in the Dream Building, situated on the Chhatra Marg, North Campus, University of Delhi, and on 13th and 14th of December (Tuesday and Wednesday). The workshop extended from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. both the days.

We also had the honour to have two dignitaries on the first day of the event, Prof. Pankaj Arora, Dean, Faculty of Education and Dean Students Welfare, University of Delhi, and Dr. Vikas Gupta, Registrar, University of Delhi.
