FORMAT OF THE COMPETITION

All National Women Student Parliament will be conducted at Four Levels:

ROUND 1- DIGITAL
ROUND 2- QUALIFYING
ROUND 3
ROUND 4- FINAL

Round 1 (Digital: Off Campus)

TOPIC: G20 Presidency can make india Vishvaguru.

- a) All interested universities must send the videos of their 3 Participants (Team Members) with about 120 seconds of each participant to the host University (Video must be uploaded on the YouTube) then shall be sent on the Competition's website of Dr. Harisingh Gour Vishwavidyalaya Sagar (M.P.). The link of the AIU Women Student Parliament website or Email will be provided soon.
- b) About 30-50 teams of different Universities will be shortlisted by a panel of 3 jury members on the basis of their videos from all over India for the Qualifying Round.

Round 2 if 30 Teams (Qualifying Round : At Host University Venue)

- a) 15 teams of different Universities will be in the Government and 15 Universities in the Opposition by draw
- b) In this round each team (any one speaker from each team) will be given a maximum of 3-5 minutes to speak on the selected bill (Topic of the House).
- c) At the end of the Qualifying Round total 10 Teams (5 Teams for the Government and 5 teams for the Opposition) will be shortlisted by the panel of 3 jury members for the Final Round.

Round 3 for remaining 20 Teams

- a) The remaining 20 teams (the teams other than 10 teams qualified for Final Round) will be given 10 minutes for the Questions & Answers. The jury member shall pick the team from the remaining 20 teams for Questions and the Speaker will select Government/Opposition team to answer the question.
- b) On the basis of the quality & the overall impression of the questions & answers; Jury shall give bonus marks to these teams.





- c) These remaining teams will also get the chance to put forth their opinions/arguments etc; for which marks will be awarded for each assertion (marks will be given by the Jury Panel).
- d) Sequence of the questions will be based on either a buzzer system or by the sequence of questions given by the speaker.
- e) From the remaining 20 teams, the teams with the highest marks on the basis of the questions/opinions/arguments etc. will get the consolation prizes.

Round 4 for 10 Teams (Final Round : At Host University Venue)

- The Final Round at the Host University will be a parliamentary debate round where 2 teams will face
 off each other. The opposing teams will be declared by the Speaker for debate.
- This will follow a Question and Answer Round (maximum 2 questions & answers) to the Teams of Parliamentary Debates (Government & Opposition Teams) and the question can be asked by any other team members.
- About 3-5 minutes will be given to each member of both the teams i.e. Government & Opposition (Approx. 30 Minutes to both teams/a maximum of 15 minutes to each team).
- Additionally, 3-5 minutes may be given by the Speaker in consultation with Jury for Direct Interjections and arguments.
- The winners of the Final Round will be declared the Overall Champion of the National Women Student Parliament.
- The other teams will become the Runner Up and First Runner Up on the basis of score.

General Rules

- A coin toss will be held between two teams. The winner of the coin toss will decide whether to be "The Government" or "The Opposition".
- The Prime Minister of the Government will pick a motion from the raffle box randomly.
- The Government will speak FOR the motion and The Opposition AGAINST the motion.
- The First Speaker will be The Prime Minister of the Government.
- The Second Speaker will be The Prime Minister of the Opposition.
- The Third Speaker will be The President of the Government.
- The Fourth Speaker will be The President of the Opposition.
- The Fifth Speaker will be The Whip of the Government.
- The Sixth Speaker will be The Whip of the Opposition.
- The Jury panel will judge both teams on the basis of their Content, Logic and Presentation skills.





Subjects for Discussion

- The matters raised in the, "AIU National Women Students Parliament." may relate to welfare activities, defence, social reforms, economic development, communal harmony, public health, education, internal security, use of modern technology, or other matters of national importance. Special emphasis may be given to issues relating to human rights, health and women education.
- No direct or indirect remarks should be made in the speeches which may cast aspersions on
 political parties or leaders/persons etc., and controversial topics based on actual events of recent
 occurrence should be avoided. It would be desirable to take up issues, based on hypothetical
 events for expounding upon the basic principles proposed to be debated.

Language

- The participants may speak in Hindi or English
- The AIU National Women Student Parliament will be organized at campus of Member University.

Evaluation of the Competition

 In competition, the performance of each team shall be evaluated by a panel of judges consisting of a Member of Parliament (preferably Woman)/Ex-Woman Member of Parliament/academicians of repute from Universities, preferably in consultation with Association of Indian Universities. AIU may depute Observer to monitor AIU National Women Student Parliament.

Team Composition

 Each university can send 3 members team of participants and maximum 2 Team officials (Manager/Teacher I/c)





IMPORTANT GUIDELINE FOR REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION

Registration Fee

Host University will charge Rs.3000/- per person from participating Universities and will provide basic facilities of board and loading, hygienic food and local transport.

Caution Money

A sum of Rs 3000/-refundable caution money has to be deposited by each team at the Registration Desk. In the event of any damage/loss of the University property caused by any participant, appropriate amount shall be charged and deducted from the Caution Money.

Travelling and Dearness Allowances

The TA/DA to the students and teachers-in-charge shall have to be borne by the respective participating Universities.

Required Documents

- •The participating students must carry their Identity Card issued by their respective Universities. The team managers should submit valid Identity cards of the participants for verification at the time of reaistration.
- •The Eligibility Certificates signed by the Dean of Students' Welfare / Cultural Coordinator/ Registrar is a must and should tally with the above documents.
- ·Age of the participants should not be more than 27 years as on 1st July 2022.
- ·All students will have to carry the copy of 10th STD mark sheet for age verification.
- ·All students will have to carry the copy of 10th STD, 12th STD and mark sheets of previously passed university exam (i.e student studying 3 rd year of college need to carry the final mark sheet of 2nd year). However, students studying 1st year of college can carry the mark sheet of 10th and 12th STD.
- Four copies of passport size photographs of each participant are to be submitted at the Reception Desk
- Vaccination Certificate Final Dose.





Accommodation

Accommodation shall be available to all the participants. The weather in the month of March will be pleasantly warm with a gentle breeze in the range of 16°C-35°C. Participants are requested to carry clothing accordingly and also carry specific medicines, locks etc.

Food

Food shall be provided in campus.

Prohibited Activities

- · Consumption of liquor / smoking.
- · Attempt to Influence the Judges.
- · Going to the press/media against the University on any controversial issue.
- · Indecent behavior inside and or outside the campus and venue and at the place of stay.
